First job as a pioneer leader




- ★ After finishing school in 1968, she wished to become a cook but she did not get the job
- ★ She started working as a pioneer leader
- ★ Pioneers were members of a mass youth organization that taught them communist values
- ★ My grandmothers job was to accompany the children in summer camps and think of fun after school activities for them



Moving to Porkuni

- ★ New job through an acquaintance
- ★ Coming to permanently live in Porkuni in 1971
- ★ Teacher to deaf children
- ★ She teached for almost 40 years, from 1971-2010



Marriage

- ★ After moving to Porkuni she met my grandfather Jaak, nicknamed Taadu
- ★ They married in 1973



Children and grandchildren

 ★ In the years 1973-1976 they had 3 children: Jaanika, Ellika, Viljar

★ By now they also have 5 grandchildren



Limestone museum

- ★ In 2002, she was offered a job as the director of the local Limestone Museum
- ★ By that time she had already worked as a teacher for 30 years
- ★ She accepted the offer and started working on two jobs at the same time
