Iga Świątek – first trainings

Iga began tennis training at the age of five and quickly began to achieve her first successes at junior level.

It was associated with a huge discipline and a certain sports routine: school, training, learning, sleep. Despite this, she did not rebel, because she enjoyed playing tennis. She understood that she was doing something special.




Iga Świątek - school

Iga studied at the Author's High School No. 42 in Warsaw. She was one of the best students in the school despite frequent absences related to training and competitions. She didn't have any problems at school. She studied on planes, in hotels, between matches and trainings.



Iga Świątek – junior successes



In 2018, at the age of 17, Iga won the junior competition:

- in the Grand Slam Wimbledon in girls' singles,
 - girls' doubles title at the French Open
- gold medal at the Youth Olympic Games held in Buenos Aires.

The first senior Grand Slam tournament in which Iga participated was the Australian Open.

However, the breakthrough was the performance in Lugano, where she reached her first final of a WTA tournament.

That same year, Iga reached the third round of the Rogers Cup in Toronto and the fourth round of the French Open.

The following season, at the Australian Open, Iga repeated her best result achieved in Grand Slam tournaments.





Iga achieved its first global success in Paris in October 2020.

At the age of 19, she won the French Open in singles.

Her victory at Roland Garros was also the first ever triumph of Polish tennis players in a Grand Slam tournament.

2022 was the best year of her career so far. It was this year that she repeated the Grand Slam success by winning Roland Garros for the second time.

In February 2022, Iga started a winning streak that included 37 wins in a row.

Her streak ended with a loss to French tennis player Alize Cornet in the third round of Wimbledon.

37 wins placed her in 1st place in the twenty-first century. She beat Serena Williams, who set a record with a 34-win streak in 2013.





In 2022, Iga won her third Grand Slam title – at the US Open in New York, becoming the first Polish woman to reach for this title.

Currently, he has won 12 tournaments in the WTA cycle.

Prestigious awards

Iga Świątek won the WTA tournament in Stuttgart, and immediately after the final she received an impressive prize - a red Porsche Taycan GTS Sport Turismo.

Half a year earlier, the Polish woman had made a driving license, which was very useful to her. After beating Aryna Sabalenka in the final, a smiling Iga Świątek drove a Porsche on the court. The honorary round of the champion was applauded by German fans.



Iga Świątek – favorite music



Iga's passion is music, which she can talk about for hours. Music relaxes her.

Before matches, she listens to rock – mainly legendary bands such as Pearl Jam, Pink Floyd, Red Hot Chilli Peppers and AC / DC, and in his free time alternative music, jazz, soul and sometimes pop.


Among her favorite bands is ABBA, which she has been listening to since the age of six.

Iga's social activities

Since the beginning of her adult tennis career, she has been involved in charity and social activities. In 2021, she donated PLN 200,000 to foundations operating in the field of children's mental health, and in the following year PLN 300,000. She was involved in helping families in need in the Noble Parcel, as well as through charity auctions in the activities of the Great Orchestra of Christmas Charity – thanks to Iga's auctions, she managed to collect over PLN 600,000 for the foundation.

The event "Iga Świątek and Friends for Ukraine" was the first large original aid project of Iga and her team, under which over PLN 2.5 million was collected for children affected by the war.
